

Evacuation Note / Leave Behind Note

When you evacuate your home or abandon your vehicle, you should leave a way for others to find you. This could be a paper note on the front door or garage door or something more visible and permanent, such as using a permanent marker or spray paint. Be sure to leave information of when you left, where you are going and how you can be contacted.

In some cases, you may not want to leave the address of where you are going. If so, use a term or reference that can be understood by someone that knows you but would not be understood by others and includes the date that you left. For example: "Went to Joe's parents' house on 2/19" or "Went to the cabin on 3/1".
